# Flux Feed and Recovery Systems Rational flux handling puts economy into your welding

- Ideal for heavy continuous welding
- Minimum manual flux handling
- Reduced flux consumption


An investment in either of these systems is a step forward to improved welding economy. You will get fewer stoppages, reduced flux consumption and savings on material costs. In addition to lower flux consumption there will be minimal spillage.

The work area can be kept cleaner and safer for the operator as manual handling can be kept at a minimum, the operator can attend to other tasks. The degree of automation in the flux handling can be decided according to type of welding station and individual requirements.

The FFRS system is designed for continuous, high-capacity welding operations. It is ideal for long runs and mass production. The system is built on two different modules: the OPC Basic and Super, which are based on the ejector principle. The Basic type is for normal welding operation. The Super is used with increased flux bed and heat conditions.

# **FFRS Basic and Super**

These are recirculated systems for continuous Submerged-Arc Welding. FFRS Basic/Super are complete equipments combining the effective recovery of flux with OPC Basic/Super systems and flux feed from the well known flux tank TPC 75, to the flux hopper with inlet (FFS).




The combination of compressed air, flux feeding, automatic fill up of new flux and continuous recovery contributes to a welding station with less down time, cleaner working environment and high quality welds as a significant result.


The system FFRS Basic and Super are built up from variants of OPC Basic/Super and Flux feed system FFS. The FFS comprises a flux tank TPC 75 with different inlets for the 6 and 10 litre flux hopper.


# **FFRS** system with:

#### **OPC Basic**




